## Phaeotephrocybe T.J. Baroni, T.W. Kuyper \& van de Peppel

Phaeotephrocybe, a monotypic species was erected by van de Peppel et al. (2022) to accommodate P. leucophylla as the type species, based on morphological characteristics and phylogenetic analysis of ITS, LSU and tef1 $\alpha$ sequence data. The type species was obtained from soil in Belize. It is characterized by very short and clavate basidia, elliptical or narrowly elliptical and smooth basidiospores, without clamp connections and arthroconidia, and with crowded and hyaline cheilocystidia. Phaeotephrocybe leucophylla is a neotropical species that is similar in general appearance compared to the European/North American Tephrocybe rancida but differs most notably in the color of the pileus, stipe and lamellae (van de Peppel et al. 2022). The taxonomic placement of Phaeotephrocybe is in Agaricales, Agaricomycetidae, Agaricomycetes, and Basidiomycota.
