The genus was introduced by [Spribile et al. \(2020\)](#) based on morphology. It is similar to *Thelocarpon*, which shares minute ascomata on organic substrata with the occasional presence of a yellow pruina, plus the multi-spored asci that gradually taper to a narrow apex. However, it differs from that genus in the more robust red-brown ascomata with the wall pigment forming magenta crystals in 10% KOH (F. Selcuk).
