Gemmina Raitv.

Gemmina includes two species comprise small, pale apothecia with short hairs, walls thin and roughened at the apex. In the past, this nondescript fungus has been placed in genera such as *Pezizella*, *Calycina*, and *Hyphodiscus* ([Raitviir 2004](#)). ITS sequences from a specimen identified as the type species, *G. gemmarum* (GenBank OM456209 and KH501127, from vouchers H.B. 6883 and SBRH 862 respectively) place the genus in *Hamatocanthoscyphaceae* (P.R. Johnston, unpubl. data).
