Graddonia (Bres.) Dennis

A specimen identified as the type species of *Graddonia*, *G. coracina* (GenBank JQ256423, voucher ILLS 60491), is strongly supported as forming a basal clade within *Tricladiaceae* (Johnston & Baschien 2020). Known only from its sexual morph, the lifestyle of this fungus is typical for *Tricladiaceae*, reported from wet habitats (Gminder 1993). The sessile apothecia have an excipular structure similar to that found in other *Tricladiaceae* (Dennis 1955) but the asci are reportedly nonamyloid.
