Ciliolarina Svrcek

Based on ITS sequences from specimens from *Pinus* from Europe identified as the type species *Ciliolarina laricina* (UNITE UDB034371) and as *Ciliolarina pinicola* (GenBank KY800411), this genus belongs in *Hamatocanthoscyphaceae* (unpubl. data). The small, often sessile apothecia with short, mostly encrusted hairs and forming on fallen coniferous wood and bark is both morphologically and in lifestyle similar to other *Hamatocanthoscyphaceae*. Huhtinen (1993) accepted six species in the genus, and a further species has since been added (Raitviir 2004).
