Deltopyxis Baral & G. Marson

Deltopyxis is a monotypic genus known only from Europe, forming minute, black, cup-shaped ascomata on dead wood and bark. The saccate, inamyloid asci are 64-spored, the ascospores more or less triangular in outline. Only rDNA sequences are available for the genus, a phylogeny based on the closest BLAST matches from the LSU sequence (OK142272) suggests a relationship with *Lecanoromycetes*, *Ostropomycetidae* (Baral et al. 2020).
