Filosporella Nawawi

Filosporella was introduced by Nawawi (1976) to accommodate *Filosporella aquatica* Nawawi as the type species. *Filosporella* is a genus of aquatic hyphomycetes from the tropics that originally was isolated from Malaysia. GenBank accessions identified as *Filosporella* fall into two phylogenetically distinct groups within *Leotiomycetes*, *Gelatinodiscaceae* and *Tricladiaceae* (Johnston & Baschien 2020). There is no genetic data available for the type species *F. aquatica*, meaning that the phylogenetic position of the genus remains uncertain. Morphology showed the genus can be placed *Helotiales* (Johnston & Baschien 2020).
