Microscypha Syd. & P. Syd.

Microscypha is a genus of small, saprobic discomycetes with short, rough-walled hairs on the apothecium. GenBank accessions labelled as *Microscypha* are from fungi in several different genera and families (Quijada et al. 2022). Recent DNA sequences from the type species *M. arenula* (= *M. grisella*) clearly places the genus in *Hyphodiscaceae* (Quijada et al. 2022).
