Ramgea is a coprophilous genus previously included in *Thelebolaceae* because of its morphological resemblance to *Thelebolus*. As shown by Quijada et al. (2022), phylogenetically it belongs in *Holwayaceae*, many of its distinctive morphological features reflecting its coprophilous lifestyle.
