Urinopezia Van Vooren

VAN VOOREN (2023) erected the monotypic genus *Urinopezia* based on morphology and phylogeny using ITS and LSU sequence data. This genus was typified by *Urinopezia tarembergensis* (Moyne, Stöckli, C. Page & Van Vooren) Van Vooren and is classified under *Pezizaceae* (*Pezizales*, *Pezizomycetes*, *Ascomycota*). The type species was found on substrates enriched by urine in Switzerland. *Urinopezia* is characterized by epigeous and cupulate ascomata; operculate, eight-spored (with croziers) asci; guttulate, and smooth ascospores; and without asexual morph. Phylogenetically, *Urinopezia tarembergensis* is positioned in a distinct clade that is closely related to both *Peziza* s. stricto and the "violacea" lineage (VAN VOOREN, 2023).
