[Helgardiomyces](#) Crous

Based on phylogenetic analyzes and morphological characters, a monotypic genus [Helgardiomyces](#) was introduced by [Crous et al. \(2021a\)](#) to accommodate *H. anguioides*. [Helgardiomyces anguioides](#) is characterized by having fast-growing cultures with long, flexuous, subcylindrical, pluriseptate conidia. Colonies of *H. anguioides* differ from those of *Oculimacula* in that they are fast growing, and dull pinkish on PDA, velvety, with an entire margin ([Crous et al. 2021a](#)) (M. Erdoğan).
