

Outlineoffungi.org - Note 282, *Millesimomyces*

Millesimomyces Crous & M.J. Wingf.

[Crous et al. \(2019d\)](#) established *Millesimomyces* to accommodate *M. rhoicissi* collected from leaves of *Rhoicissus digitata*. *Millesimomyces* resembles *Discosia* in morphology, having stromatic acervuli, and long, hyaline, subcylindrical or lageniform phialides that give rise to subcylindrical, pale brown, 3-septate conidia with eccentric apical and basal appendages (Liu et al. 2019). However, based on phylogenetic inference, the fungus clusters apart from species of *Discosia* ([Crous et al. 2019d](#)) (M. Erdoğan).
