Palaeocurvularia Dörfelt & A.R. Schmidt

In the idea of Schmidt, Dörfelt, Struwe & Perrichot (fossil), this monotypic genus of conidiogenous fungus (*Pleosporaceae*, *Pleosporales*) was recorded from the faecal pellets of insect embedded in amber, collected from the Cretaceous sediments of Ethiopia. It resembles spores of extant genera *Helminthosporium* Link, *Drechslera* S. Ito, *Curvularia* Boedijn, *Bipolaris* Shoemaker and *Exserohilum* K.J. Leonard & Suggs (R.K. Saxena).
