

**Outlineoffungi.org - Note 453, [Rhynchobrunnera](#)**

[Rhynchobrunnera](#) B.A. McDonald et al.

[Rhynchobrunnera](#) was introduced by [Crous et al. \(2021a\)](#) to accommodate species that have 1–3-septate, straight conidia lacking apical beaks. It is similar to members of *Rhynchosporium*, but with different conidial morphology. Conidia solitary, subcylindrical, straight, (0-)1-3-septate, hyaline, hilum neither thickened nor darkened; conidial secession schizolytic ([Crous et al. 2021a](#)) (M. Erdoğan).
