[Phaeonawawia](#) Goh

The monotypic genus [Phaeonawawia](#) within *Chaetosphaeriaceae* was introduced by [Goh et al. \(2021\)](#) to accommodate [P. diplocladielloidea](#) collected from decaying wood submerged in freshwater. The fungus is generically distinct in the brown, short-stalked, bulbose or urceolate conidiogenous cells with a terminal pore rimmed with a flared collarete, producing large, dematiaceous, versicolored, multi-euseptate, tetrahedral, or obpyramidal stauroconidia, which bear hyaline filiform appendages at the end of the arms and enclosed by a thick, hyaline sheath ([Goh et al. 2021](#)) (M. Erdoğan).
