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[Paramacroventuria](#) Crous & Bulgakov

[Paramacroventuria](#) was introduced by Crous et al. (2021) to accommodate its type species, *P. ribis* Crous & Bulgakov, and belongs to the family *Didymellaceae*. This monotypic genus is known from its asexual morph, and is characterized by brown, medially septate, ellipsoid conidia, with a truncate hilum at the base, and percurrently proliferating conidiogenous cells (Crous et al. 2021). Based on phylogenetic analysis using LSU, ITS, *rpb2* and *tub2* datasets, [Paramacroventuria](#) clustered close to the genera *Macroventuria* Aa and *Juxtiphoma* Valenzuela-Lopez, Cano, Crous, Guarro & Stchigel (Crous et al. 2021). However, members of *Macroventuria* are all observed by the features from the sexual morph (Hou et al. 2020a), and *Juxtiphoma* species produce chlamydospores (Valenzuela-Lopez et al. 2018, Hou et al. 2020b, Yasanthika et al. 2021), which are lacking in [Paramacroventuria](#). [Paramacroventuria](#) was recorded as a pathogen causing leaf spots on *Ribes aureum* in Russia (Crous et al. 2021).
